

Servsafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Missouri

In Missouri, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Missouri.

Although service training is voluntary, if sampling service is provided in a licensed retail establishment with employees that pour and serve liquor samples. It may be required to complete an approved server training program.
