

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



New Hampshire

New Hampshire does not regulate training at the server level. However, licensees and designated managers must take a mandatory Management Training Seminar (MTS) provided by the New Hampshire State Liquor Commission.

Training staff and managers in responsible alcohol service principles, including state and local laws, may be considered a mitigating factor by the commission in the event of a violation. The ServSafe Alcohol™ program meets these qualifications in New Hampshire.

No forms or documentation need to be submitted to the Commission when employees are certified through the ServSafe Alcohol program. It is recommended that licensees keep a record of all trained employees for possible mitigation benefits in the future.
