ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



New York

In New York, responsible alcohol service training is <u>voluntary with mitigating benefits</u>. ServSafe Alcohol™ classroom and online training is a recognized program in New York.

Mitigating benefit: The New York State Liquor Authority (NYSLA) will consider training a mitigating factor (affirmative defense) if, at the time of violation, the person who committed the violation held a valid certificate of completion or renewal from a certified alcohol training awareness program (ATAP) provider and the licensee diligently implemented and complied with the training program.

The New York State Restaurant Association Educational Foundation (NYSRAEF) is a certified ATAP school.
