

## ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



### New York

In New York, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary with mitigating benefits. ServSafe Alcohol™ classroom and online training is a recognized program in New York.

Mitigating benefit: The New York State Liquor Authority (NYSLA) will consider training a mitigating factor (affirmative defense) if, at the time of violation, the person who committed the violation held a valid certificate of completion or renewal from a certified alcohol training awareness program (ATAP) provider and the licensee diligently implemented and complied with the training program.
