

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



North Dakota

In North Dakota, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary with mitigating benefits. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in North Dakota.

Mitigating benefits: If licensee's employees have taken an approved alcohol server training course that addressed intoxication, drunk driving, and underage drinking. Having this taken will lessen the punishment/penalty to the retail licensee.
