

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

Rhode Island

In Rhode Island, <u>all employees</u>, including supervisory employees, who sell or serve alcohol or check I.D.'s and valet parking staff <u>must</u> complete alcohol server training. Employees must complete training within 60 days from their date of hire. Servers must be recertified every 3 years by completing an approved training program.

There is a supplement for Rhode Island that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the Rhode Island supplement at <u>ServSafe Supplements</u>.
