

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



South Dakota

In South Dakota, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary with mitigating benefits. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in South Dakota.

Mitigating benefit: The fines for first and second violations are cut in half for the licensee if the employee who sells or serves alcohol to a minor has completed an approved alcohol training program.

There is a supplement for South Dakota that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the South Dakota supplement at [ServSafe Supplements](#) .
