

## **ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines: Washington D.C.**



In the District of Columbia, responsible alcohol service training is mandatory for managers. The ServSafe Alcohol™ Classroom and Online Program is currently approved for use in the District of Columbia.

Managers must have a manager's license to manage a licensed establishment. The manager's license is valid for 2 years. The fee covers both years that the license is valid and is paid at the time that the manager applies for the license. The application is available at <https://abra.dc.gov/node/668732>

Managers must complete an approved alcohol server training course prior to applying for a manager's license. Proof of certification must be submitted to ABRA on a form provided by the approved course provider. Managers must renew their certification every 2 years.
