

## ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



### Wyoming

In Wyoming, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary with mitigating benefits. ServSafe Alcohol® is an approved program in Wyoming.

Mitigating benefits: There may be possible mitigation benefits. Please contact the Liquor Division for more information.

Voluntary alcohol server training through a division-approved provider must be at least 4 hours in length. Servers are certified upon successfully completing course and passing exam and the certification lasts 3 years.

Instructor certification is valid for one year, instructors must be recertified with the approved course provider annually.
